








Reception Project: What is magic? – Autumn 2 2021

This term we are exploring what magic is to us. We will start the term by looking at lots of different types of magical potions. We will be developing our imagination, following instructions, colour mixing and learning lots of new vocabulary. We will also be learning about the magic that is inside us and talking about resilience and kindness. As we move through the term we will read a range of different magical stories and learn a few magic tricks.

At the end of the term we will focus on the magic of Christmas and finally celebrate with our Christmas performance, Christmas party and trip to see the pantomime Sleeping Beauty at the theatre.

 <p>Personal Social and Emotional Development</p>	Emotions, how music makes us feel, Zones of regulation, friendship, kindness, antibullying week and resilience.
 <p>Communication and Language</p>	Developing attention and listening skills, vocabulary development, individual targets,
 <p>Physical Development</p>	Letter formation and fine motor strength development yoga, changing speed, emotions and styles of movement JB sports
 <p>Literacy</p>	Phonics Little Wandle letters and Sounds revised, Whole class guided reading, group guided reading phonics sessions, reading for pleasure class reading books, drop everything and read, spelling CVC words
 <p>Mathematics</p>	Early numbers, 1:1 correspondence, representations, subitising, comparing and ordering, 2D shapes, patterns, language related to time, simple addition.
 <p>Understanding the World</p>	Bonfire night, Diwali, Christmas, changing seasons, magicians, cooking, world culture day – The Gambia
 <p>Expressive Arts and Design</p>	Mark making to music, developing drawing and colouring skills, adding detail, colour mixing, resilience, sticking and joining.
